Boone County Hospital is committed to bettering our community's healthcare. As a full service hospital, Boone County Hospital provides comprehensive care and patient-centered services that are managed and delivered by a skilled staff of medical professionals.

## OUR FOUNDATION

In 1991, the Boone County Hospital Foundation was formed by a group of concerned local citizens to help the hospital carry out its mission to provide the county and surrounding area with the best possible health care.

The Foundation is an incorporated, non-profit organization formed to provide appropriate avenues of funding for the hospital's patient services, capital expenses and equipment needs. It has its own Board of Directors made up of individuals who volunteer their time and talents to the Foundation.

## GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

Private support plays a key role in the hospital's mission. Giving opportunities include gifts in the form of an unrestricted fund, an endowment fund, memorials, and other areas of programming and services. Gifts may be restricted by donors to a particular specialty or program while unrestricted gifts are directed by the Foundation Board to help meet the most vital needs of the hospital.

## GIVING OPTIONS

Donations are tax-deductible and may be made in several forms, including cash, credit cards, securities, real estate, life insurance and bequests. Donors can also establish charitable gift annuities and charitable remainder trusts which create an ongoing income for the Foundation.

The **"Adopt-A-Room"** program sponsors a patient room within Boone County Hospital. By adopting a room, you can help provide essential and decorative furnishings as well as state-of-the art equipment. In recognition of your generosity, we will display a plaque outside your adopted room. A minimum gift for the Adopt-A-Room fund is \$5,000.

A **"Tribute Gift"** can be given in memory (deceased), or in honor (living), of a relative, co-worker or a friend. We will promptly acknowledge your gift to the individual whom you name, to inform them of your thoughtfulness. A tribute gift can be in any amount.

The **"Family and Friends Patient Comfort (Hospice) Rooms"** are to be completed in winter 2005. These rooms will provide families and friends of Hospice patients the type of privacy and special accommodations needed at such a difficult time. A gift of any amount can be made for the on-going upkeep of the rooms, as well as a Hospice nurse education fund. The rooms will be able to accommodate many other types of patients when not being used for Hospice care.

The **"New Equipment"** fund allows Boone County Hospital to retain state-of-the-art equipment.

An **"Endowment Fund"** has been set up for on-going needs of the Hospital. Gifts of any amount can be indicated toward specific areas at the discretion of the donor.



**"Inscribed bricks"** can be purchased within either garden at Boone County Hospital. A personally inscribed brick will become part of the garden walkways. Any special person, group or occasion can be commemorated. The cost for an inscribed brick is \$50 each.

**"The Gardens"** of Boone County Hospital are natural settings of artful plantings and flowers. Comfortable nooks scattered throughout the gardens are designed to provide restful areas for the enjoyment of patients, visitors and staff.
