Reach Out and Read

hildren ages six months to six years attending a well child exam at Boone County Family Medicine (BCFM) in Boone will now receive a children's book to help foster an early introduction to reading and literacy.

The new clinic initiative is part of the Reach Out and Read Program, a nationwide program that prepares America's youngest children to succeed in school by partnering with doctors to provide books and encourage families to read together. Doctors, nurses and other health professionals incorporate Reach Out and Read's evidence-based model into regular pediatric check-ups by advising parents about the importance of reading aloud and giving developmentally appropriate books to children.

"We became involved in the program because our physicians have always believed reading to children helps develop their dialog and promotes good communication between the child and parent," says Angi Ellsworth, RN, BCFM Clinic Manager. "Partnering with the Ericson Public Library and the Reach Out and Read Program has followed the activities our providers have promoted all along. Thanks to donations from the Boone Lion's Club, we are able to provide each child beginning at six months of age to six years a new book at their well child visit."



Thanks to the generous donation from the Boone Lion Clubs, approximately 500 books have been purchased which should last the clinic about one year.



your health and the health of your family, providing convenient access to specialized medical services is important to Boone County Hospital (BCH). The Specialty Clinic at BCH offers a broad range of health care services in one comfortable location. Visiting physicians from clinics outside of Boone rotate through the clinic holding office hours throughout the month. Whether you need to see an allergist, a cardiologist or an orthopedic surgeon, the Specialty Clinic offers nearly 20 specialties with 30 providers, all in Boone, and all for your convenience!

"Our Specialty Clinic is a major perk for Boone County Hospital," says Heather Cook, RN, CRNI, BCH Specialty Clinic Director. "Many people don't realize the variety of healthcare services we have available. We essentially offer as many services as the bigger healthcare systems, and we have some of the best providers in central lowa coming here to provide care to the residents from in and around our community."

The Specialty Clinic has been a service at BCH for more than 20 years. and the spectrum of services and providers continues to grow. In the past five years, hepatology, the branch of medicine that incorporates the study of liver, gallbladder, biliary tree, and pancreas, and additional dermatology services have been added. Also, three additional orthopedic surgeons joined the clinic to make a total of four, in the summer of 2014, all of which have surgery privileges at BCH. Along with the visiting



"We are lucky to have a great working relationship with the physicians and staff that come to the hospital each month," says Heather. "The providers, who come from Ames, Des Moines, Fort Dodge and Newton, work nicely together to keep patients in Boone, so they do not need to travel out of town to the home office of the physician. The providers also work well with the BCH Medical Staff."

Other services offered by the Specialty Clinic are free blood pressure checks each Friday morning in the clinic and a Cancer Support Group the third Tuesday of each month, 6:30 p.m., in the BCH 1st Floor Conference Room.
