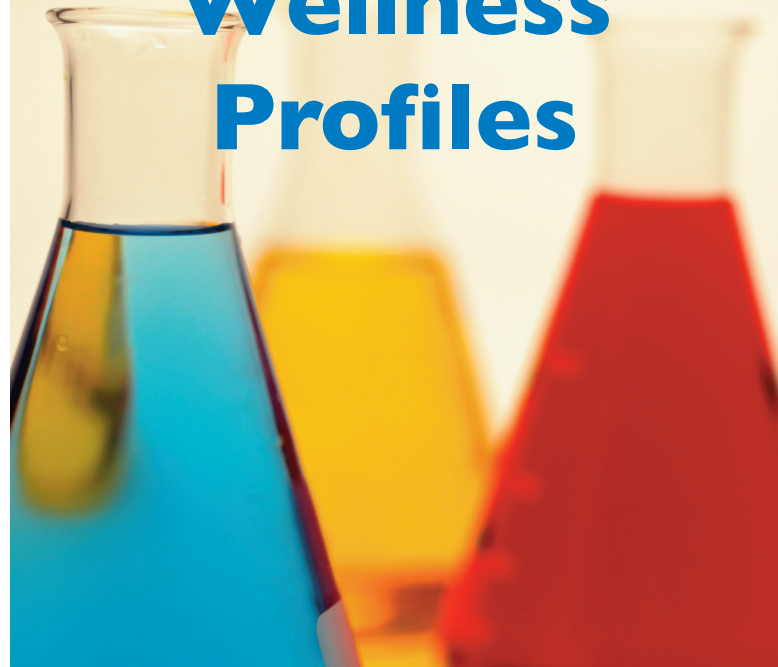

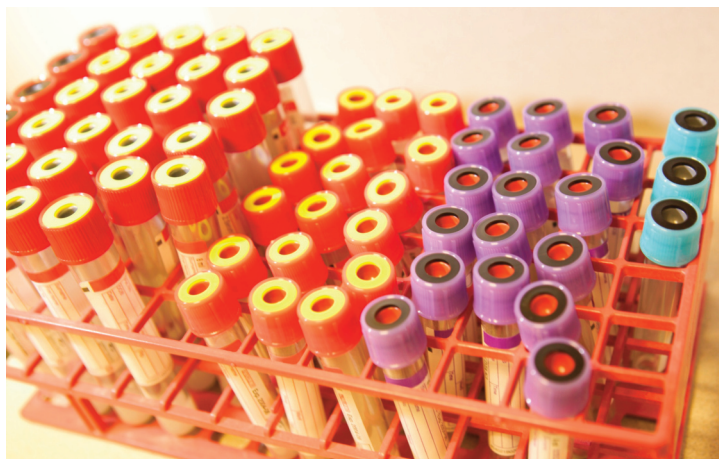

Boone County Hospital (BCH) offers inexpensive blood tests and no appointment is necessary.

BCH provides you the opportunity to have your blood tested without going through your physician. If you want to know your blood type, your cholesterol level or if you have concerns about diabetes, anemia or prostate cancer, our walk-in wellness tests are for you. Costs are kept low because you pay up-front, and no insurance filing is necessary.

Our profiles are offered Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, 7 a.m. to noon.

Prior to your lab test, stop by Patient Registration in the Atrium of BCH for the proper consent form and to pay. The consent form states the results of your lab tests will be mailed to you upon their completion and your physician will not receive any results without your consent.



All Profiles

- Require a 12 hour fasting period prior to blood being drawn.
- Include our pathologist's interpretation with the exception of the ABO/RH wellness.
- Can be combined.



All profile results will be mailed to your home within 72 hours.
